PVSC, Memorial Middle School Environmental Club to Unveil Eco-Village Project

FAIR LAWN - The Passaic Valley Sewerage Commissioners (PVSC) and Memorial Middle School will be hosting an unveiling event at the middle school on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 at 2:00 p.m.

The event will showcase the project of Memorial's Environmental Club, which will include a small scale composting facility the group will implement to introduce composting to the school. Funding for this project was made possible through a \$1,000 grant from the Bergen County Utilities Authority. Also, a local student will be developing a replica Native American home on site as part of an Eagle Scout project.

"Memorial's Eco-Village will allow students to experience composting first hand by placing in the materials and observing what is produced," said Memorial science teacher Craig Cohen. "This will generate new ideas that will help us reduce our solid waste."

PVSC cleared and mulched the area at Memorial Middle School where the composting facility and student display will be erected. PVSC has had a long relationship with Fair Lawn and Memorial Middle School, having developed a river walk behind the school, constructing an observation deck on the river bank, and building a kayak/canoe launch for the borough over the last five years.
