## NJ CSO Group Citizen Advisory Committee Forming!

Your input is critical to protecting our water.

Did you know that your community has a Combined Sewer System that discharges sewage into local waters during heavy rains? The US Environmental Protection Agency and the NJ Department of Environmental Protection are evaluating potential changes to our aging infrastructure, which will ultimately cost you money. Many options need to be discussed to reach the goal of a cleaner environment.

A *Citizen Advisory Committee* is now forming to explore issues and options related to Combined Sewer Systems and their effect on New Jersey's waterways.

*The Citizen Advisory Committee is open to any interested person or group.*

The committee will hear presentations, offer feedback, learn about alternatives and their estimated costs and benefits and, ultimately, make recommendations. The committee will conclude in January 2007, and a *Program Report* will be submitted to the *NJ Department of Environmental Protection* summarizing the group's findings.
